DAY  
**1****Be On the Lookout**

This week, pray that God will help you show love to others. Then look for chances to show love to those around you. You can use kind words to encourage someone, helpful actions for people in need, and generous gifts for those who lack something. Every evening, before you go to bed, **ASK** God to give you the ability to show love to those around you. Prayer: "God, help me see those around me who need help. Give me the ability to help them. I ask that through my help they would see your love for them. Amen."

DAY  
**2****Make a Gift Basket**

Find out the foods and snacks a member of the family or one of your friends likes. With the help of an adult, make a "just because" gift basket for your friend or family member. Give it to them on a day that is not a special day. **KNOW** that your gift shows love to the person you gave it to.

DAY  
**3****Write a Note**

Jesus loves us so we should work to love other people. Find some nice things to say about a friend or family member. With the help of a grown-up, write an encouraging note for this person. Include a drawing if you think it would make them smile. **THINK** about how you can show love to others through your words every day.

**4****Throw a Party**

With a grown up's permission, ask if you can invite some friends over. Plan some games. Have some food. Make sure everyone has a good time. Just like when Lydia opened her home to Paul in the Bible Story, you are showing love by opening your home to others. This is called showing hospitality. **LOOK** at the fun your guests are having and know that this party shows God's love to those you invited.
